

JOE FAFARD

Joe Fafard is an internationally acclaimed sculptor and printmaker who is best known for his endless study of bovine creatures.

Joe Fafard was born September 2, 1942 in Saint Marthe, Saskatchewan. His interest in drawing and sculpting began at home where he often retreated from his large family to quietly nurture his artistic talent. Following high school, Joe attended the University of Manitoba where he received his Bachelor of Fine Arts degree in 1966. He then moved to the United States where he attended Pennsylvania State College and received his Master of Fine Arts degree in 1968. Joe returned to Canada and taught sculpture for six years at the University of Saskatchewan in Regina. In 1974, Joe Fafard began to sculpt full time in a studio in Pense, Saskatchewan. It was here that he portrayed many of the towns folk and put this little town and himself on the contemporary Canadian art map. Joe currently resides in Regina and continues to be a prolific and highly successful artist.

Joe has exhibited his work widely in Canada, the United States and in Europe, and is included in many private, public and corporate collections. Joe Fafard has received many awards, including the Order of Canada in 1981 and the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada Allied Arts Award in 1987.

The print "BARB" shows Joe's expressive use of line in his typically metaphorical imagery. This newborn calf is full of natural wonderment, yet is hemmed in by barbed wire as a flock of crows fly freely overhead. Joe has produced many prints throughout his career. This five colour serigraph shows the subtlety of his approach to printmaking, creating the illusion of a soft conte drawing with progressive layers of ink. When commenting on why he chose the screen printing process for this image Joe said "I'd do a litho, but that would be too easy". "BARB" is a classic image for Joe, representing his constant challenge with both image and process.







Joe Fafard was born September 2, 1942, in Ste. Marthe, Saskatchewan. He attended the University of Manitoba, Winnipeg (B.S.A. 1966), Pennsylvania State University, State College (M.F.A. 1968); was an instructor in sculpture, University of Saskatchewan, Regina, from 1968 to 1974; and visiting lecturer in sculpture, University of California at Davis, winter semester 1980-81.

He is the recipient of numerous awards, including the Order of Canada (Officer) in 1981 and the Royal Architectural Institute of Canada Award in 1987. From 1971 to 1984 Fafard lived in Pense, Saskatchewan; in 1984 he moved to Regina where he currently resides. In 1985 he opened a foundry, Juliene Atelier Inc., in Pense. His work is exhibited and extensively collected throughout Canada and the United States.

The retrospective, "Joe Fafard: The Bronze Years", featuring major sculptures by Fafard from the years 1983 - 1995, will be on view at the Montreal Museum of Fine Arts from November 21, 1996 to February 16, 1997.




